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



soul of whom you know and she reassures your soul in Iesus'

name.

It passed over your soul like a shadow of vainglory; it was like a veil through which Satan tried to strike you, but he didn't succeed. Perhaps you were unaware of it. You certainly did not assent to the very subtle suggestion, so there is no sin on your part, not even venial. This should comfort you and cause you to burst out in acts of thanksgiving to the Lord. But - as that soul says - it was a warning. I know and you yourself are also aware that Satan has been routed and can no longer harm you. But certain it is that as long as you live you must work out your own salvation in fear and trembling 1.

Humility, therefore, humility and always humility. Satan fears and trembles before humble souls. The Lord is willing to do great things, but on condition that we are truly

humble.

Attribute everything, then, to Jesus and may he alone be glorified in you and through you! Please do not worry, therefore, but at the same time continue to live in great humility, fear of God, perfect love for God and your neighbour, blind obedience to authority and to those who direct you in God's name.

Saint of the Day: September 6:

Memorial 6 September Patron Saint

Born: 3 September 1907 in Ayoó de Vidriales, Zamora, Spain

Died: the night of 6 September 1936 in Peón cemetery, Gijón, Asturias,

Spain

Also known as: Domitilo of Ayoó



Felipe joined the Franciscan Capuchins on 2 August 1923, taking the name Domitilo of Ayoó; he made his religious profession on 3 August 1924. Ordained a priest on 30 May 1931. He became known as a passionate preacher.

Father Domitilo was arrested on 3 August 1936 in the early days of the Spanish Civil War for the offense of being a priest and for continuing to preach in the streets after the war started. While in custody, he refused to remove his Capuchin habit, ministered to other prisoners, and spoke of forgiveness instead of revenge. His final acts, in the cemetery where he and 22 fellow prisoners were executed, was to give sacramental absolution to the other victims. Martyr.

Beatified: 13 October 2013 by Pope Francis

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St Maximilian Kolbe O.F.M. Conv. (1894 - 1941)

A letter of St Maximilian Kolbe --- We must sanctify the whole world.

I rejoice greatly, dear brother, at the outstanding zeal that drives you to promote the glory of God. It is sad to see how in our times the disease called "indifferentism" is spreading in all its forms, not just among those in the world but also among the members of religious orders. But indeed, since God is worthy of infinite glory, it is our first and most pressing duty to give him such glory as we, in our weakness, can manage – even though we would never, poor exiled creatures that we are, be able to render him such glory as he truly deserves.

Because God's glory shines through most brightly in the salvation of the souls that Christ redeemed with his own blood, let it be the chief concern of the apostolic life to bring salvation and an increase in holiness to as many souls as possible. Let me briefly outline the best way to achieve this end – both for the glory of God and for the sanctification of the greatest number. God, who is infinite knowledge and infinite wisdom, knows perfectly what is to be done to give him glory, and in the clearest way possible makes his will known to us through his vice-gerents on Earth.

It is obedience and obedience alone that shows us God's will with certainty. Of course, our superiors may err, but it cannot happen that we, holding fast to our obedience, should be led into error by this. There is only one exception: if the superior commands something that would obviously involve breaking God's law, however slightly. In that case the superior could not be acting as a faithful interpreter of God's will.

God himself is the one infinite, wise, holy, and merciful Lord, our Creator and our Father, the beginning and the end, wisdom, power, and love – God is all these. Anything that is apart from God has value only in so far as it is brought back to him, the Founder of all things, the Redeemer of mankind, the final end of all creation. Thus, he himself makes his holy will known to us through his vice-gerents on Earth and draws us to himself, and through us – for so he has willed – draws other souls too, and unites them to himself with an ever more perfect love.

See then, brother, the tremendous honour of the position that God in his kindness has placed us in. Through obedience we transcend our own limitations and align ourselves with God's will, which, with infinite wisdom and prudence, guides us to do what is best. Moreover, as we become filled with the divine will, which no created thing can resist, so we become stronger than all others.

This is the path of wisdom and prudence; this is the one way by which we can come to give God the highest glory. After all, if there had been another, better way, Christ would certainly have shown it to us, by word and by example. But in fact, sacred Scripture wraps up his entire long life in Nazareth with the words *and he was obedient to them* and it shows the rest of his life to have been passed in similar obedience – almost as an instruction to us – by showing how he came down to Earth to do the Father's will.

Brethren, let us love him above all, our most loving heavenly Father, and let our obedience be a sign of this perfect love, especially when we have to sacrifice our own wills in the process. And as for a book from which to learn how to grow in the love of God, there is no better book than Jesus Christ crucified.

All this we will achieve more easily through the intercession of the Immaculate Virgin, to whom the most kind God has given the task of dispensing his mercies. There is no doubt that the will of Mary should be the will of God for us. When we dedicate ourselves to him, we become tools in her hands just as she became a tool in his. Let us let her direct us and lead us by the hand. Let us be calm and serene under her guidance: she will foresee all things for us, provide all things, swiftly fulfil our needs both bodily and spiritual, and keep away from us all difficulty and suffering.

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Mark your Calendars

Some important dates for the Padre Pio Prayer Groups:

January

- 6 [1903] At age 15, he entered the Capuchin Novitiate in Morcone, Italy.
- 21 [1990] The beatification process was completed.
- 22 [1903] Investiture into the Capuchin Order taking the Franciscan habit and the name Brother Pio.
- 27 [1907] Brother Pio took his final vows.

February

- 9 [1940] Work was started on Padre Pio's "Grand Earthly Undertaking", namely the building of his "House for the Relief of Suffering".
- 17 [1916] He was appointed to the monastery of Sant'Anna in Foggia.

March

- 16 [1918] Padre Pio returned to the monastery of SAN Giovanni Rotondo for good.
- 20 [1983] The official inquiry into Padre Pio's case was opened in San Giovanni Rotondo.

April

• 22 [1925] Resenting the restrictions placed on Padre Pio's confessional duties, the faithful throughout the country were again in a state of turmoil.

May

- 2 [1999] Padre Pio of Pietrelcina was officially beatified by John Paul II.
- 5 [1956] The House for the Relief of Suffering was officially opened.
- 15 [1919] His superiors call for the first medical examination of his stigmata by Dr. Romanelli. On July 26, 1919, he was examined by Dr. Bignami and on October 9, 1919 by Dr. Festa.
- 23 [1987] The Holy Father, John Paul II, made a pilgrimage to San Giovanni Rotondo and prayed at Padre Pio's tomb.
- **25** [1887] Padre Pio (Francesco Forgione) was born at 5:00 pm in Pietrelcina (Benevento) to Grazio Forgione and Maria Giuseppa (Peppa) Di Nunzio.
- 26 [1887] Little Francesco was baptised in the church of Sant'Anna.

June

- 16 [2002] Padre Pio of Pietrelcina was officially canonized by John Paul II.
- 17 [1923] Padre Pio was debarred from saying Mass in public or replying to any of the letters arriving at the monastery in San Giovanni Rotondo.
- 25 [1923] A popular revolt broke out on the afternoon of the day when Padre Pio first said Mass in a private chapel.
- 26 [1923] Padre Pio resumed saying Masses in the church.

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July

- 1 [2004] The new Sanctuary of St Pio of Pietrelcina was consecrated in San Giovanni Rotondo.
- 16 [1933] Padre Pio resumed saying Masses in public following a two-year suspension.
- **26** [1919] Padre Pio was examined by Professor Amico Bignami, head of the medical pathology department of the University of Rome.
- 28 [1916] During a period of suffocating heat, he was taken to the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo and stayed there one week.
- 31 [1968] His Prayer Groups are given official recognition by the Vatican.

August

- **5 [1918]** Through the work of a mysterious celestial being, Padre Pio's heart was pierced by a spear, leaving him with a wound that was to bleed for the rest of his life. This phenomenon is known as "transverberation".
- 8 [1923] Padre Pio was ordered to move to Ancona.
- 10 [1910] At twenty-three years old, he was ordained a priest by Archbishop Paolo Schinosi in the Cathedral in Benevento, Italy.
- 11 Feast of St Claire of Assisi
- 14 [1910] Said his first Mass at Our Lady of the Angels parish in Pietrelcina.
- 17 [1923] Worried by the restlessness of the crowds, the ecclesiastical authorities suspended the order for Padre Pio to move to Ancona.

September

- 4 [1916] Assigned to Our Lady of Grace Monastery in San Giovanni Rotondo.
- 20 [1918] Received the visible stigmata while praying before a crucifix in the monastery church of Our Lady of Grace; a mysterious person dripping with blood in the chapel appeared to him, then he found that he himself now had wounds on his hands, rib cage and feet. From then on, Padre Pio's body was marked with stigmata, the visible signs of the Passion of Christ. He became the first priest in the history of the Catholic Church to bear the stigmata.
- 22 [1968] Padre Pio said Mass at 5 a.m. as usual. This was to be his last celebration of the Eucharist.
- 23 Feast St Padre Pio of Pietrelcina
- 23 [1968] Padre Pio died at 02.30, his last words being "Jesus, Mary! Jesus, Mary!" The Father Guardian of the Monastery stated that ten minutes after Padre Pio's death, all traces of the stigmata on his hands, feet and side had disappeared.
- 26 [1968] Over a hundred thousand people attended his funeral.
- 27 [1968] The crypt containing Padre Pio's body was opened to the public and was visited by droves of pilgrims over the years.

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October

- 4 Feast of St Franci of Assisi
- 9 [1919] At the request of the General of the Capuchins, Padre Venanzio from Lisle-en-Rigault, Padre Pio underwent in-depth medical examinations conducted by Dr Giorgio Festa.
- 10 [1915] He told his Superior that he had been suffering the pain inflicted by flagellation and the crowning of thorns for years now.

November

- 6 [1915] Drafted into the Italian Army. On Dec. 6, he was assigned to the 10th Medical Corps in Naples. Due to poor health, he was continually discharged and recalled until March 16, 1918 when he was declared unfit for military service.
- 12 [1917] He returned to the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo, where he stayed until 5 March 1918, the year when he resumed national service in Naples.

December

- 18 [1916] He went to Naples on national service, but his poor physical conditions made the doctors send him home on special leave.
- [21 [1998] The scientifically unexplainable healing of Mrs. Consiglia De Martino of Salerno, Italy, needed miracle for beatification, is approved by Congregation for the Cause of Saints.
- [2000] The scientifically unexplainable healing of 7-year-old Matteo Collela of San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy, needed miracle for canonization, is approved by Congregation for the Cause of the Saints.

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
